STAR TEST WINDOW II

The faculty and I had the opportunity to analyze the STAR test results for the second window last month and the results are amazing! Ninety-five percent of our classes met their goals for the STAR Test Window II. We had a few classes that surpassed their goal by almost 20%. School-wide we had a median growth percentage of almost 70% in both, Reading and Math. The academic growth has been truly impressive! We are particularly proud of our TK students who took the STAR test for the first time in November. The TK class scored 200 points above average, AMAZING! More Important News

School Year 2019-2020

Now that the holidays are over, we need to start preparing for the following school year. We will follow the same registration process as this school year. The registration fee will be divided into two payments: re-registration fee (\$50) and general fee (\$325). The re-registration form and the new tuition cost letter will be sent home on January 15th. (Please check the family envelopes that are sent home every Tuesday). This form along with the re-registration fee of \$50 for each returning student will be due on **February 15th**. If submitted after February 16th, the fee will increase to \$75 per student. Once we receive the re-registration form and payment, we will send home the Parent Agreement and SMART form. Please register early so that you can pay the lowest amount possible.

This re-registration process allows us to have a clear number of returning students early in the year and helps us plan for the following year. It is essential that you submit the re-registration form on time. This year we were blessed with having a wait list for one class and had a couple of classes close to having a waiting list.

The General Fee of \$325 per child will be due **March 15th**. This includes workbooks, student agendas, technology, and PE equipment. Once the Re-registration fee, general fee, and special fees (if applicable) are paid, we will send the raffle tickets home. This will allow you to sell the raffle tickets to friends and family without having to cover that fee out of pocket. The fundraising fee (raffle tickets) is due on **May 31st**.

Remember that a registration is considered complete only when the Re-registration and General fees have been paid, the SMART form is signed and complete, and the Parent Agreement is signed and on file in the office. Our goal is to have ALL students fully registered by June.
