Applies to grade 6th through 8th

Student Supplies:

- 1 pair of adult scissors (must have all year)
- 1 binder for Literature and Religion
- 1 pack of dividers for binder
- 1 zipper pencil pouch
- 1 package of highlighters (at least 3) for personal note taking (colors optional)
- 1 box of crayons (24 count)
- 1 box of colored pencils (24 count)
- 1 protractor - needed for math
- 1 Master Lock Dial Combination Padlock (Black and Silver color only – We ask new students to practice locking and unlocking padlock over the summer break☺)
- 2 packs of 12 black or blue pens (NO erasable pens)
- 1 pack of red pens, (NO erasable pens)
- 1 pack of dry erase markers (to be used in Math)
- 2 durable 1 inch binders – one for Math and one to keep returned work in an organized manner
- 1 Pack of dividers to be use in binder
- 1 Composition notebook – needed for Math
- 1 pack of index cards (size 3x5, count-200 – will be used for note taking; studying for test)
