SCHOOL YEAR 2021-2022

Now that the holidays are over, we need to start preparing for the following school year. We will follow the same registration process as this school year. Due to the pandemic, due dates have been extended. This will give you more time to cover the fees.

The registration fee will be divided into two payments: re-registration fee (\$50) and general fee (\$325). The re-registration form and the new tuition cost letter will be sent home on January 8th with the classwork packets. This form along with the re-registration fee of \$50 for each returning student will be due on **Friday, March 5th**. If submitted after March 5th, the fee will increase to \$80 per student. If submitted after July 30th, the fee will increase to \$100. Once we receive the re-registration form and payment, we will send home the Parent Agreement and SMART form. Please register early so that you can pay the lowest amount possible. Our goal is to have all students fully registered by the end of July.

This re-registration process allows us to have a clear number of returning students early in the year and helps us plan for the following year. It is essential that you submit the re-registration form on time.

The General Fee of \$325 per child will be due **Friday, April 16th**. This includes workbooks, student agendas, technology, and PE equipment. Once the Re-registration fee and general fee are paid, we will send the raffle tickets home. This will allow you to sell the raffle tickets to friends and family without having to cover that fee out of pocket. The fundraising fee (raffle tickets) is due on **Friday, May 14th**. Any applicable special fees are due **Friday, May 28th**.

SCHOOL FIESTA RAFFLE TICKETS

As I informed you last month, due to the pandemic our school fiesta has been canceled for a second year. The school fiesta is our biggest fundraiser event. The cancellation has had a financial effect on our school budget. We had to make several cuts in order to cover our school expenses and keep our doors open; therefore, we ask for your support. We will replace our school fiesta with a raffle. First prize will be \$10,000. We are asking our school families to sell only 10 raffle tickets each. If you are able to sell more tickets, that would help us tremendously. The raffle tickets will replace your service hours for the second part of the school year. TK-2nd GRADE SCHOOL WAIVER AND RETURN TO SCHOOL

As I informed you last month, our school waiver process has been completed. Our COVID-19 School Safety Plan was approved by the Department of Catholic Schools and the LA Department of Public Health. Last month we completed the last part of the process which was an inspection by the LA Department of Public Health. We had previously planned to have our TK-2nd grade students return to school for in-person instruction on Jan. 12th, however, due to the surge in positive COVID-19 cases, we have decided for everyone's safety to postpone the starting date to Feb. 9th. We are hoping and praying that the numbers will go down and it will be safer to return to school for in-person instruction. I will keep you informed of any changes.

Once in-person instruction begins, we will continue providing the remote learning option. There will be a mandatory meeting for parents who feel comfortable sending their child to school for in-person instruction on Wednesday, Feb. 3rd. I will send the Zoom link as we get closer to the date. Thank you for your support and patience during these unprecedented times.

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
