Admission Policies 2022-2023 Academic Year

The criteria listed below will be used in determining admission to Mary Immaculate School.

Priority will be given to:

Families who are Catholic and

- registered in Mary Immaculate Parish
- attend Mass regularly, using the numbered offering envelopes
- support parish activities
- already have children in the school

Students who:

- transfer from another Catholic school
- take entrance exam before June 30, 2022

Families will need to commit to certain parental obligations as described below:

- 40 service hours; families receiving a scholarship through the school need to complete 50 service hours
- 5 service hours at the school fiesta
- maintain a Catholic atmosphere in your home to help your child grow in his/her faith
- act in a Christian manner at all school and parish events
- fulfill Family Fundraising obligation
- pay tuition through SMART in a timely manner

School Student Non-Discrimination Policy
